Subject: Amendment of RRs for the post of Medical Officer and framing of RRs for the post of Sr. Medical Officer (Specialist Grade-II).

This relates to the proposal for amendment of RRs for the post of **Medical Officer** and framing of RRs for the post of **Sr. Medical Officer (Specialist Grade-II)**. The proposal has been examined in consultation with DoP&T and following observations are made –

- (i) Whether the officers included in the DPC (Departmental Promotion Committee) are one level above or not. It is to be ensured that the officers including in the DPC is one level above to the post for which the promotion is to be considered.
- (ii) The proposal should be uploaded on the website of NEPA for 30 days for inviting comments from the stakeholders as per provisions of DoP&T OM No. 14017/61/2008-Estt(RR) dated 13.10.2015.



Notification

G.S.R.- In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution and in supersession of the North Eastern Police Academy (Group 'A' Post) Recruitment Rules 1988, except as respects things done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the President hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to **Group 'A' Medical Post** [Medical Officer – Level 10 & Senior Medical Officer (Specialist Grade) – Level 11] in the Ministry of Home Affairs, North Eastern Police Academy, Barapani, Shillong, namely:-

1. Short title and commencement.- (1) These rules may be called the North Eastern Police Academy, Barapani, Medical Officer (Group 'A') post Recruitment Rules, 2016.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the official Gazette.

2. Number of post, classification and pay level in the pay matrix. - The number of post, its classification and the pay level in the pay matrix attached thereto shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the Schedule annexed to these rules.

3. Method of recruitment, age- limit, qualification etc.- The method of recruitment, age limit, qualification and other matters relating to the said post shall be as specified in columns (5) to (13) of the said Schedule.

4. Disqualification. - No person,
(a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or
(b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person,
shall be eligible for appointment to the said posts:

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and other party to the marriage and there are other grounds for so doing exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

5. Power to relax.- Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order, for reasons to be recorded in writing and in consultation with the Union Public Service Commission relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

6. Saving. - Nothing in these rules shall affect reservation, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Schedule Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, the Ex-Serviceman and other special categories of persons in accordance with the order issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.
