NOTIFICATION

New Delhi, the -----2023

- G.S.R.____. In exercise of the powers conferred by proviso to article 309 of the Constitution, and in supersession of the in supersession of the North Eastern Police Academy, Barapani (Group 'A' posts) Recruitment Rules, 1981 except as respect things done or omitted to be done before such suppression, the President hereby makes the following rules for regulating the method of recruitment to the post of Additional Director in the Ministry of Home Affairs, North Eastern Police Academy, Barapani, Shillong, namely:-
- **1. Short title and commencement.—** (1) These rules may be called the Ministry of Home Affairs, North Eastern Police Academy, Group 'A' Post Recruitment Rules, 2023.
- (2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
- **2. Application.-** These rules shall apply to the posts specified in column (1) of the Scheduled annexed to these rules.
- **3. Number of post, classification, pay band and grade pay or pay scale.-** The number of post, its classifications the pay band and grade pay or pay scale attached thereto shall be as specified in column (2) to (4) of the Schedule annexed these rules.
- **4. Method of recruitment, age limit, qualifications etc.-** The method of recruitment, age limit, qualifications and other matters relating to the said post shall be as specified in columns (5) to (13) of the Schedule are exist to these rules.
- 5. Disqualification.- No person,
- (a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living, or
- (b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person, shall be eligible for appointment to the said post;

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

- **6. Power to Relax -** Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order and for reasons to be recorded in writing and in consultation with Union Public Service Commission relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.
- **7. Saving -** Nothing in these rules shall affect reservations, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Scheduled Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, ex-servicemen and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.

- (i) holding analogous post on regular basis; or
- ii) Officers in the rank of Senior Superintendent of Police or Commandant or Assistant Inspector General of Central Government or State Governments or Union territories with two years regular service in the Pay Band-4(Rs.37400-67000) and Grade pay of Rs. 8700; or
- (iii) Officers in the rank of Second-in-Command (2i/c) or equivalent post in the pay band-3 (Rs. 15600-39100) and Grade pay of Rs. 7600 with six years regular service; and possessing of the following experience;

Experience of 12 years in the field of administration, Planning, execution and establishment in Policing.

- Note 1. Period of deputation including the period of deputation in another ex-cadre post held immediately preceding this appointment in the same or some other organizations/ department of the Central Government shall not exceed five years.
- Note 2. The maximum age limit for appointment by deputation shall not be exceeding fifty six years, as on the closing date of receipt of applications.

Note 3. – For the purpose of appointment on deputation basis, the service rendered on a regular basis by an officer prior to the 1st January, 2006 or the date from which the revised pay structure based on the recommendations of the Sixth Central Pay Commission has been extended, shall be deemed to be service rendered in the corresponding grade pay or pay scale extended based on the recommendations of the said Pay Commission except where there has been merger of more than one pre-revised scale of pay into one grade with a common grade pay or pay scale, and where this benefit will extend only for the post(s) for which that grade pay or pay scale is the normal replacement grade without any up-gradation.
