

FROM THE DIRECTOR'S DESK



The annual Football Tournament 2021 was organized by the Sports Club of 50th Basic Course, North Eastern Police Academy.



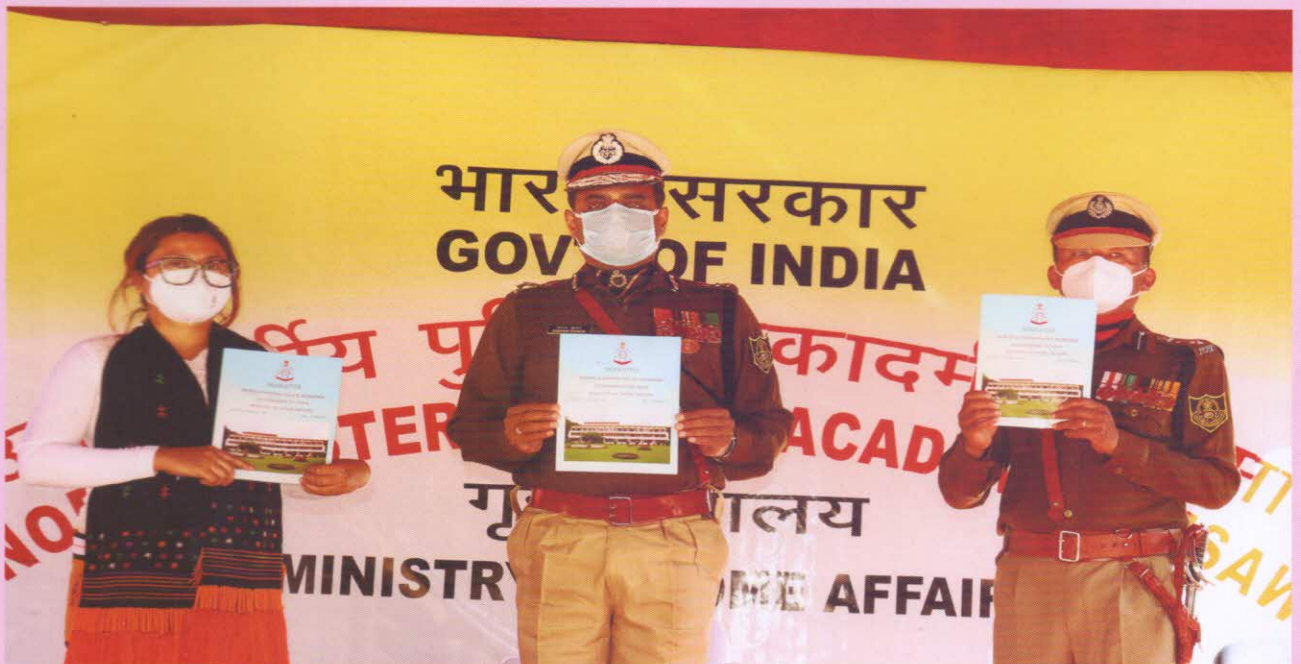
CULTURAL PROGRAMME

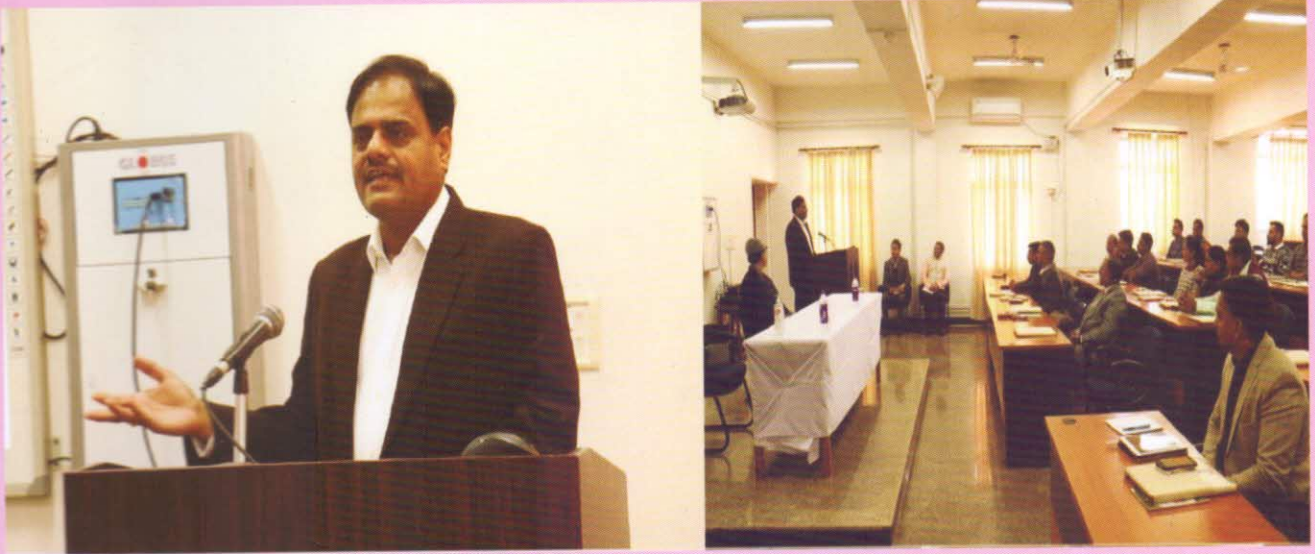
PASSING OUT PARADE OF 49TH BASIC COURSE

2. Three weeks Internship Programme for Eight (08) interns from Sardar Patel University, Jodhpur was conducted from the 3rd to 23rd of January 2022



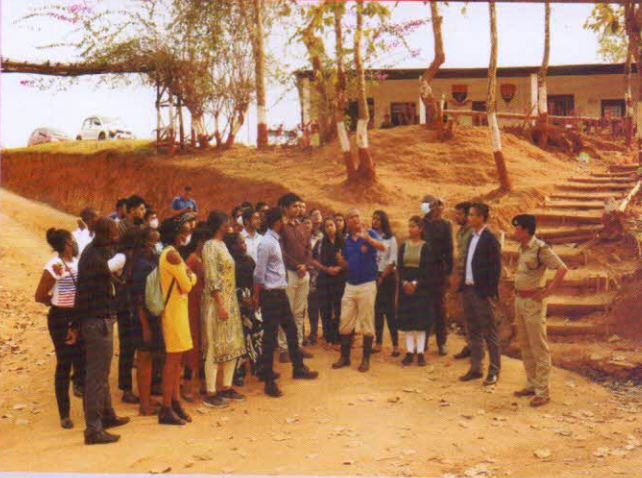

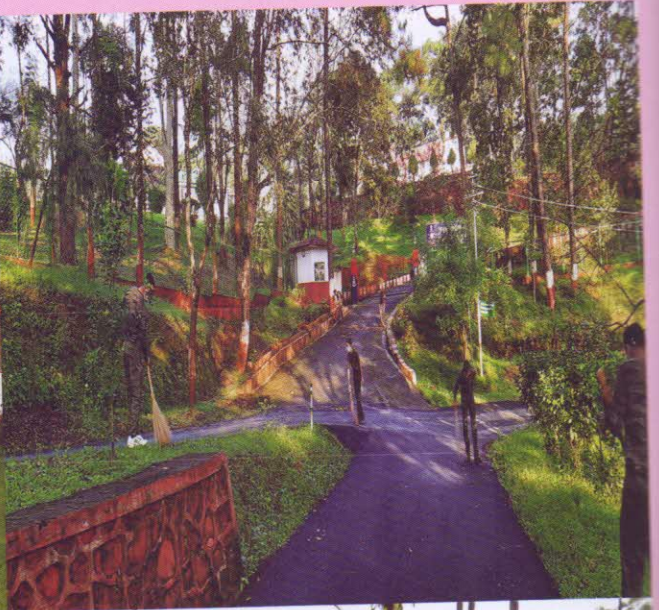


HOMELAND SECURITY COURSE

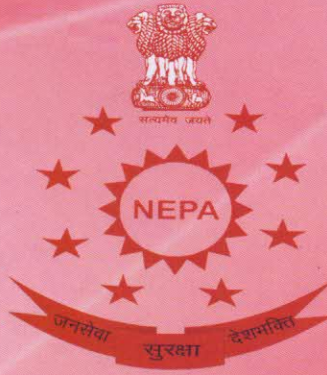
