North Eastern Police Academy is the premier police training institution of Government of India for imparting training to directly recruited Deputy Superintendent of Police and Sub-Inspectors of all eight North Eastern States. The Academy is located at Umsaw Village in Ri-Bhoi District of Meghalaya, 20 Km from Shillong and 83 Km from Guwahati on the Shillong-Guwahati National Highway. Nearest Airport is Shillong Airport which is 12 Km from Academy.



History

The Academy was initially established as Regional Police Training College (RPTC) with the administrative approval of the President of India on the recommendation of Gore Committee on police reform and came into existence from 21st July, 1978. Shri Aftab Ahmed Ali, IPS was appointed as 1st Commandant of RPTC. Later on RPTC was upgraded and re-named as North Eastern Police Academy in May 1980.

Campus

The Academy is spread over an area of 205 acres with all types of modern facilities for training in the midst of a rich reserve of flora and fauna and surrounded by picturesque Pine trees. The beautiful sprawling, neat and clean pollution free environment of the Academy makes it the best place for training.

TRAINING

Courses

1. Basic Course for Directly recruited Deputy Superintendents of Police and Sub-Inspectors (50 weeks)

During the course the trainees are given basic training in Law, Police Science, Social Science, Police Operation & Tactics, Physical Training, Weapon Training and Drill necessary for the discharge of duties by a police personnel.

Basic course Trainees are also being awarded Post Graduate Diploma in Police Administration & Investigation from Sardar Patel University of Police, Security & Criminal Justice, Jodhpur.

2. In- service Courses

The Academy organizes various short term / specialized courses for officers of police, judiciary, prosecution, CAPFs and other departments on various subjects like CCTNS, Prison Reforms, Cyber crime, Cyber Forensics, Scientific Investigation, Soft Skills, Law, Disaster Management, CIJW, etc.

3. Webinars and Online Courses

The Academy also conducts webinars and online courses on Right To Information, Cybercrime, NDPS, Forensic Science and on other subjects.

4. Foreign Participants

The Academy imparts training to the police officers of friendly neighbouring countries.
