NOTIFICATION

New Delhi, the 3rd January, 2014

G.S.R. 10(E).—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution and in supersession of the North Eastern Police Academy, Barapani (Group 'A' posts) Recruitment Rules 1981, except as respect things done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the President hereby makes the following rules for regulating the method of recruitment to the post of Additional Director in the Ministry of Home Affairs, North Eastern Police Academy, Barapani, Shillong, namely :—

1. Short title and commencement.—(1) These rules may be called the Ministry of Home Affairs, North Eastern Police Academy, Barapani, Group 'A' Post Recruitment Rules, 2014.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. Application.—These rules shall apply to the posts specified in column (1) of the Schedule annexed to these rules.

3. Number of post, classification, pay band and grade pay or pay scale.—The number of post, its classifications the pay band and grade pay or pay scale attached thereto shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the Schedule annexed these rules.

4. Method of recruitment, age limit, qualifications etc.—The method of recruitment, age limit, qualifications and other matters relating to the said post shall be as specified in columns (5) to (13) of the Schedule are exist to these rules.

5. Disqualification.—No person,

(a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living, or

(b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person,

shall be eligible for appointment to the said post:

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and other party to the marriage and there are other grounds for so doing exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

6. Power to relax.—Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may in consultation with the Union Public Service Commission by order and for reasons to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

7. Saving.—Nothing in these rules shall affect reservation, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Schedule Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, the ex-serviceman, and other special categories of persons in accordance with the order issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.

		on pre-revised scale of pay into one grade with a common grade pay or pay scale, and where this benefit will extend only for the post(s) for which that grade pay or pay scale is the normal replacement grade without any up-gradation.
