**NOTIFICATION**

New Delhi, the 25th April, 2012

**G.S.R. 334(E).**—In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to article 309 of the Constitution, the President hereby makes the following rules for regulating the method of recruitment to the posts of Inspector (Trainer of Training), Inspector (Training), Head Constable (Motor Transport Mechanic) and Constable (Motor Transport Mechanic) in the Ministry of Home Affairs, North Eastern Police Academy, Barapani, Shillong, namely :—

1. **Short title and commencement.**- (1) These rules may be called the North Eastern Police Academy, Barapani, Group 'C' posts Recruitment Rules, 2012.  
(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the official Gazette.
2. **Application.** - These rules shall apply to the posts specified in column (1) of the Schedule annexed to these rules.
3. **Number of posts, Classification and pay band and grade pay or pay scale.** - The number of posts, their classification and the pay band and grade pay or pay scale attached thereto shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the said Schedule.
4. **Method of recruitment, age- limit, qualification etc.**- The method of recruitment, age limit, qualification and other matters relating to the said posts shall be as specified in columns (5) to (13) of the aforesaid Schedule.
5. **Disqualification.** - No person,  
(a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or  
(b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person, shall be eligible for appointment to the said posts:

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and other party to the marriage and there are other grounds for so doing exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

6. **Power to relax.**- Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order for reasons to be recorded in writing, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.
7. **Saving.** - Nothing in these rules shall affect reservation, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Schedule Castes, the Scheduled Tribes and other special categories of persons in accordance with the order issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.

**For deputation.-**

- i) Officers of the Central Government or State Government or Union Territories holding analogous post on regular basis with grade pay of Rs. 4200/-; or
- ii) Sub-Inspector of Central Armed Police Forces or State Police or Union Territories with five years regular service in the grade pay of Rs. 2800/- having experience in teaching outdoor subjects.

**Note 1.-**Period of deputation including the period of deputation in another ex-cadre post held immediately preceding this appointment



in the same or some other organizations or department of the Central Government shall be three years initially, which can be extendable up-to five years. The maximum age limit for appointment by deputation shall not be exceeding fifty six years, as on the closing date of receipt of application.

**Note 2.** - For the purpose of computing minimum qualifying service for promotion, the service rendered on a regular basis by an officer prior to 1<sup>st</sup> January, 2006, the date from which the revised pay structure based on the 6<sup>th</sup> Central Pay Commission recommendations has been extended, shall be deemed to be service rendered in the corresponding grade pay or pay scale extended based on the recommendations of the Commission. For purposes of appointment on deputation or absorption basis, the service rendered on a regular basis by an officer prior to 1<sup>st</sup> January, 2006, the date from which the revised pay structure based on the 6<sup>th</sup> Central Pay Commission recommendations has been extended, shall be deemed to be service rendered in the corresponding grade pay or pay scale extended based on the recommendations of the Commission, except where there has been merger of more than one pre-revised scale of pay into one grade with a common grade pay or pay scale, and where this benefit will extend only for the post(s) for which that grade pay or pay scale is the normal replacement grade without any upgradation.
