G.S.R. 465(E).—In exercise of the powers conferred by the provision to article 309 of the Constitution and in supersession of the North Eastern Police Academy, Barapani, Group 'A' and 'B' posts' Recruitment Rules, 2014, in so far as they relate to the posts of Assistant Director (Scientific Aids) at serial no. 3 and Deputy Assistant Director (Police Science – for 01 post only) at serial no. 6 of the Schedule to the said rules, except as respect things done or omitted to be done before such supersession, the President hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the posts of Assistant Director (Scientific Aids) and Deputy Assistant Director (Forensic Science) in the Ministry of Home Affairs, North Eastern Police Academy, Barapani, namely:-

1. **Short title and commencement.**- (1) These rules may be called the North Eastern Police Academy, Barapani, Assistant Director (Scientific Aids) and Deputy Assistant Director (Forensic Science) Recruitment Rules, 2016.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.

2. **Number of posts, classification, and level in the pay matrix.**- The number of posts, their classification and level in the pay matrix attached thereto, shall be as specified in columns (2) to (4) of the Schedule annexed to these rules.

3. **Method of recruitment, age limit, qualification, etc.**- The method of recruitment, age limit, qualification and other matters relating to the said posts shall be as specified in columns (5) to (13) of the aforesaid Schedule.

4. **Disqualification.** - No person,-

(a) who has entered into or contracted a marriage with a person having a spouse living; or

(b) who, having a spouse living, has entered into or contracted a marriage with any person,

shall be eligible for appointment to the said posts:

Provided that the Central Government may, if satisfied that such marriage is permissible under the personal law applicable to such person and the other party to the marriage and that there are other grounds for so doing, exempt any person from the operation of this rule.

5. **Power to relax.**- Where the Central Government is of the opinion that it is necessary or expedient so to do, it may, by order, for reasons to be recorded in writing and in consultation with the Union Public Service Commission, relax any of the provisions of these rules with respect to any class or category of persons.

6. **Saving.** - Nothing in these rules shall affect reservation, relaxation of age limit and other concessions required to be provided for the Schedule Castes, the Scheduled Tribes, the Ex-serviceman, the other Backward Classes and other special categories of persons in accordance with the orders issued by the Central Government from time to time in this regard.

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	<p>Note 3: The maximum age limit for appointment by deputation (ISTC) shall be not exceeding 56 years as on the closing date of receipt of applications.</p> <p>Note 4: For the purpose of appointment on deputation basis, the service rendered on a regular basis by an officer prior to 1st January, 2016 or the date from which the revised pay structure based on the Seventh Central Pay Commission recommendations has been extended, shall be deemed to be service rendered in the corresponding level in the pay matrix extended based on the recommendations of the said Pay Commission.</p>
